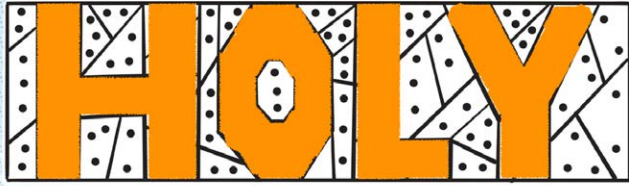

Stained Glass | Use the key to color the picture and discover the hidden word.

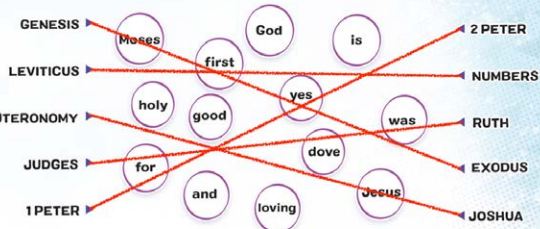
